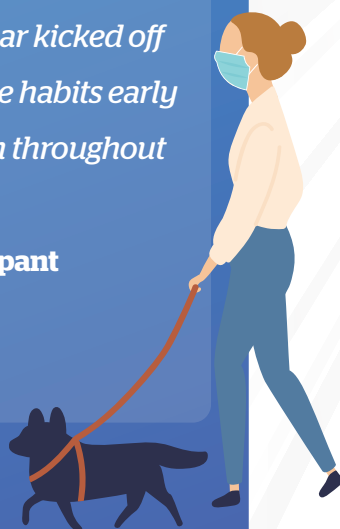
Activating Municipalities and Institutions to Prioritize Health and Well-Being for all Texans

The Community Challenge engages community leaders, educators and families to come together to embrace health as a shared value. This year **17,975 participants** and **331 communities** took part in the Challenge.

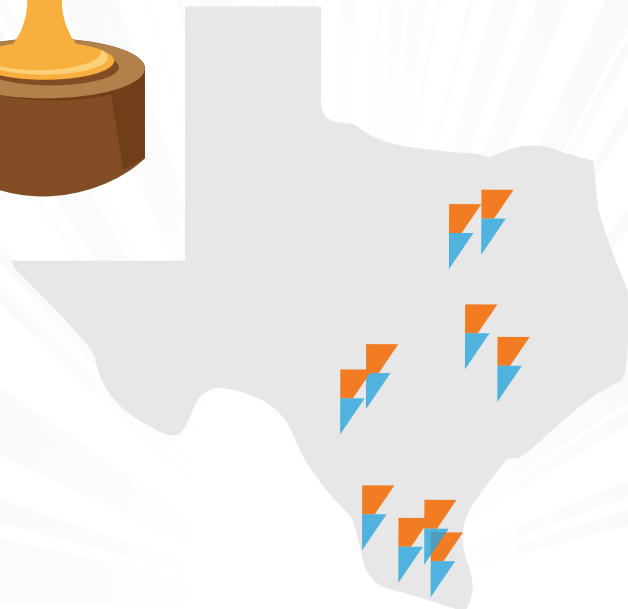

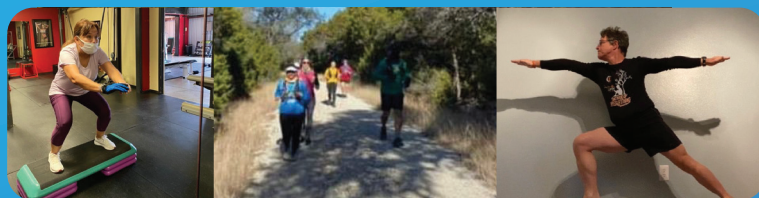
Participants averaged **38 healthy activities in 2021** vs. an average of 21 activities in 2020

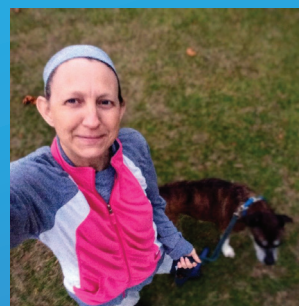
